- Target Toss Float hula hoops or rings in the water and toss soft balls or beanbags to score points. It's simple, safe, and fun for swimmers of all ages.
- Floatie Races Hop onto your favorite inflatable and race to the other end of the
 pool without falling off. This game brings out everyone's playful side and sense
 of balance.
- Aqua Freeze Dance Turn up your favorite summer tunes and dance in the water. When the music stops—freeze! It's energetic, silly, and perfect for families or friends of all ages.
- Mermaid Relay No arms allowed! Swimmers must complete a lap using only their legs or a mermaid tail float. It's a fun, fitness-friendly challenge that sparks lots of laughter.
- Soaking Sponge Toss Trade water balloons for extra-large wet sponges. Players toss them back and forth, trying not to drop or squeeze them. Great for cooling off and encouraging teamwork.
- Cold Coin Challenge Freeze coins or small plastic treasures overnight and toss them in the pool. Swimmers race to collect and "thaw" the icy treasures—a perfect way to stay cool on a hot day.
